Installation Instructions and Issues Addressed

This patch will take :

DataEase 6.5 (280/2090) to DataEase 6.5 Patch 1 (283/2093)

To install and run the patch

- 1) Download the file
- 2) Unzip this file into a temporary directory
- 3) Choose Start, Run and run the unzipped 65patch1.exe

This patch addresses a number of issues reported in earlier versions

Fixed Problems

- 4519 Tabbing through a lookup field causes "Save Changes?" message on close even though nothing has been changed."
- 4696 A procedure which modifies a record on screen (after previously being saved) causes "Save Changes" message to be displayed when form closed or next record clicked even though there are no other changes"
- 4836 Cannot copy pull-down menu items from one form to another on Win98SE.
- 4869 On Win98SE, I look at the form's properties, the "Report" option button is enabled but both "Print" and "Live" are greyed out but as soon as I click on "Report" DataEase locks up and requires a Ctrl-Alt-Del to clear
- 4879 Print documents produce extra output.
- 4882 When printing a one page report a second blank page is also produced.
- 4883 When compiling a control procedure all the procedures/reports will also run. If you have a "Record Entry" statement the relevant form will also be opened."
- 4886 Ceil and Floor round instead of functioning as they should
- 4889 Forms or menus do not display any of their custom menus when users initially log on to an application.
- 4896 Action spreads on other elements
- 4897 Taborder works incorrectly in some cases.
- 4899 Creating a form to arrange records in groups leads to GPF or no items"
- 4910 Clicked event on field object fails if called document is a control procedure. If the DQL includes a form being opened, we get an invalid form handle error
- 4915 Erroneous cannot search items on records in groups - try the "parent record" message when doing an AltF5 search within a sub-form. The document in question is NOT a Group By form."

Fixed Problems with OLE DB

- 4725 ole db consumer: existing data cannot be viewed and new data cannot be entered in forms over tables reverse engineered from Oracle
- 4762 oledb: a DataEase error message appears if an existing record in form over a table in an oledb datalink is updated and saved, and then the next record is accessed
- 4763 oledb: data can be entered and saved in lookup fields that does not match data in the related table when the table with the lookup field is in an oledb datalink
- 4785 oledb consumer and provider: the cursor will not enter fields of form over tables in an Access database
- 4904 oledb consumer: yes/no fields in Access are not being mapped to DE through an oledb datalink
